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MAHNAZ COLLECTION'S UPCOMING EXHIBITION: LONDON ORIGINALS

The latest exhibition is set to open this spring.

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Mahnaz Collection is set to unveil a new jewelry exhibition later this month at New York's Wright gallery. Curated by Mahnaz Ispahani Bartos, the exhibit, titled "London Originals: The Jeweler's Art in Radical Times," is set to showcase works by a number of pioneering jewelers, including Andrew Grima, John Donald and Wendy Ramshaw, working in London throughout the 1960s and '70s. It was a period defined not only as a renaissance of sorts for British jewelers, but also of sweeping cultural changes across fashion, art, music, design and youth culture. Featuring 150 rarified pieces, the exhibition, explains Bartos, is "reflective of the broader cultural movement [at that time]," one in which "the London Originals argued for the elevation of value of design and the hand of the maker, and opened once more the question of the relationship of jewelry to art and design." Experience the celebrated jewels first hand when "London Originals" opens at Wright, located at 980 Madison Avenue in New York, from April 11th to May 11th 2018.
